From Portland

From the intersection of Highway 217 and Highway 210 (Scholls Ferry Road), drive west approximately 10 miles on Highway 210 to the flashing yellow light. A sign reads "Scholls Next Left."

Turn left (south) on Highway 210. Cross the bridge and proceed through the small town of Scholls. Continue south at the intersection of Highways 219 and 210, following the sign "Highway 219 to Newberg."

Two miles south of Scholls, turn right (west) on Vanderschuere Road.

Travel 2 miles to the first stop sign. Turn left (south) on Neugebauer Road.

Travel 1/4 mile and turn right (west) on Wildhaven Lane (a gravel drive). Travel to the end of the lane. There is an iron gate and callbox at the entrance.

From Newberg

From the intersection of Highway 219 (College Street) and Highway 99W (First Street), drive north approximately 10 miles on Highway 219, up and over the summit of the Chehalem Mountains. Watch mileposts for reference.

Continue north on Highway 219 down the opposite side of the mountain.

Turn left (west) on Vanderschuere Road, just past milepost 11 and Mountainside Cemetery.

Travel 2 miles to the first stop sign. Turn left (south) on Neugebauer Road.

Travel 1/4 mile and turn right (west) on Wildhaven Lane (a gravel drive). Travel to the end of the lane. There is an iron gate and callbox at the entrance.

From Gaston

From Gaston, drive south on Highway 47 toward Yamhill.

At the first opportunity, turn left (east) on Flett Road.

Travel 1 mile and turn left (north) on Spring Hill Road.

Continue on Spring Hill Road and turn right (east) on Laurel Valley Road.

Continue on Laurel Valley Road through the small town of Laurel, through the mountains, and passing Buffalo Ranch (on the left).

Continue to Bald Peak Road and turn left.

When Bald Peak Road makes a hairpin turn to the left, stay on Laurel Valley Road and continue straight downhill.

Turn right on McCormick Hill Road.

Turn left on Vanderschuere Road.

Turn right on Neugebauer Road.

Travel 1/4 mile and turn right (west) on Wildhaven Lane (a gravel drive). Travel to the end of the lane. There is an iron gate and callbox at the entrance.
